The expansion of the Court of Appeal and the Office of the Director of Public Prosecutions is a specific target within the JRIP and also has implications for the release of significant budgetary support in relation to the European Union's 11 th EDF. A deliverable under the JRIP is to establish sound court infrastructure. The Reform action #47 requires the Ministry to develop a Court Facilities Master Plan.
