#### **ELIGIBILITY OF SUPPLIERS**

- Proof of valid registration with the Public Procurement Commission (PPC), in the Category: Building Construction - Grade 1 (minimum)
- Copy of a valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC).

**Non-compliance with all or any of the two criteria above will result in an automatic disqualification of tender.**
