1. The Ministry of Justice (MOJ) is seeking to recruit suitably qualified persons to fill the position of **Parish Child Diversion Officer (GMG/SEG 2) (vacant)** in the Child Diversion Branch (St. Thomas), Social Justice Division; salary range \$4,266,270.00 - \$5,737,658.00 per annum.

JOB PURPOSE

Under the direction of the Director, Child Diversion, the Parish Child Diversion Officer works at the parish level, providing management oversight for the Child Diversion Programme, which is aimed at providing an alternative to formal judicial proceedings for children who are accused of or have committed certain specified offences. The Child Diversion Officer must ensure that the Programme is operationalized within the assigned parish.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATION AND EXPERIENCE

- Bachelor's Degree in Social Work, Arts or Social Sciences (or comparable qualification and experience);
- Minimum of four (4) years working experience in low-income communities, with at least three (3) years working with at-risk children;
- Experience working with young people within the criminal justice system would be an asset.
