Under the direction of the Director, Restorative Justice, the Parish Restorative Justice Officer works at the parish level, managing several vulnerable and volatile communities. They implement the Restorative Justice (RJ) programme at the community level throughout their designated parish.

The incumbent manages all RJ Facilitators and volunteers, and coordinates the work with other stakeholders in the assigned communities, including both referral agencies (Police, Courts, Department of Corrections, Victim Services Officers, Ministers of Religion and Schools, etc.) and supporting agencies (NGOs offering support in activities such as parenting classes, government departments that offer health services, including counseling, etc.) to ensure the successful implementation of the RJ programme. The Parish RJ Officer also coordinates efforts pertaining to arbitration duties and matters with the Child Diversion Specialist.
