

STATEMENT OF MAJOR (DR) GAIL RANGLIN-EDWARDS


I am Major (Dr.) Gail RANGLIN-EDWARDS a registered Medical Practitioner in the island of Jamaica and I am a Commissioned Officer of the Jamaica Defence Force (JDF). I joined the JDF on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of May 2009. I am presently the Force Medical Officer and the keeper of the medical records in the JDF. In keeping with item (h) of the terms of reference for the commission of Enquiry, I have been requested by the attorneys representing the JDF to supply medical information regarding the JDF personnel who were shot, killed or injured during the Internal Security Operation in Tivoli Gardens in May 2010

As the current keeper of the records, I have checked the records of the JDF regarding soldiers who were shot, killed or injured during the Operation and they are as follows:

1.	Pte	JAMES, Carlington	Gunshot wound to left palm with open fracture to 3 <sup>rd</sup> and 4 <sup>th</sup> phalanges (fingers).
2.	Pte	MARSHALL, Glenroy	Gunshot wound to the distal aspect of the right arm with open fracture to the right humerus
3.	LCpl	MCLARTHY, Thwaites	Heat exhaustion
4.	LCpl	ROACH, George	Gunshot wound to right arm and leg
5.	Pte	BROWN, Damion	Gunshot wound to right posterior shoulder (scapular region)
6.	Pte	LAWRENCE, Davion	Gunshot wound (shrapnel injury) to the left neck (above sternoclavicular joint) with heamo-pneumothorax.
7.	Pte	MOULTON, Shaun	Fall from truck with blunt trauma to back and abdomen (Lumbar spasm)
8.	Sgt	GRANT, Clive	Blast injury to left leg with Above-Knee Amputation (AKA), Fracture to left finger
9.	Pte	GREEN, Maurice	Gunshot wound to Head (FATAL)
10.	LCpl	ROBINSON, J	Gunshot wound to left buttock
11.	LCpl	HYLTON, M	Gunshot wound to left hand with extensive soft tissue injury (inclusive of tendons), open fractures to 1 <sup>st</sup> & 2 <sup>nd</sup> metacarpal bones, 1 <sup>st</sup> proximal phalanx (fingers)
12.	Pte	FENTON, M	Multiple gunshot wounds to right thigh, left inguinal (groin) region and left scrotum
13.	Pte	MCHAYLE, C	Shrapnel injury to left forearm
14.	LCpl	GILZENE, W	Laceration to left hand
15.	LCpl	MCCURDY, Shegorie	Lower back trauma
16.	Pte	CLARKE, B	Trauma to right knee

17.	LCpl	LYNCH, L	Shrapnel injury to left temple (forehead)
18.	LCpl	WADE, R	Dehydration
19.	Pte	JOHNSON, R	Blunt trauma to left eye
20.	Pte	LAWRENCE, Dextor	Twisted (soft tissue injury) to left ankle
21.	Pte	WILLOCK, Dwight	Laceration to left palm and soft tissue injury to left knee.
22.	Cpl	JOHNSON, Lomax	Gunshot wound to right axilla (arm)
23.	Cpl	RILEY, Michael	Shrapnel injury to left side of face (below the left eye)
24.	LCpl	CLARKE, Richard	Head injury (blunt trauma)
25.	Pte	ADAMS, Kerrado	Head injury (blunt trauma)
26.	Pte	FOSTER, Andre	Soft tissue injury right forearm from blunt trauma with subsequent cellulitis
